6 非常配置表

6-1 非常配置表

船員法には、次に掲げる船舶の船長に、非常事態に対する乗組員の作業に関して 非常配置表を定め、船内の適当な場所に掲示すること、並びに乗組員及び船客に操 練を実施することが規定されています。

(1) 非常配置表を作成して掲示する船舶(以下「非常配置表適用船舶」という。)

- ① 旅客船(平水区域を航行区域とするものは、指定航路に就航するものに限る。)
- ② 遠洋区域または近海区域を航行区域とする非旅客船
- ③ 特定高速船 (SOLAS条約「高速船コード」適用船)
- ④ 漁船(専ら沿海区域において操業するものを除く。)

(2) 非常配置表に記載する内容

- ① 乗組員の配置
 - ア)水密戸等の閉鎖、排水・防水作業
 - イ)防火戸等の閉鎖、通風の遮断、防火設備の操作及び消火作業
 - ウ)救命艇、救命いかだ及び救助艇への物品搭載、降下、操縦並びに救助作業
 - エ)救命設備の操作
 - 才)招集及び誘導、救命胴衣着用の確認その他船客の安全を確保する作業

② 現場指揮者及び代行者

- ア)防水及び消防作業
- イ)救命艇、救命いかだ及び救助艇作業
- ウ)救命艇及び救助艇の機関、無線通信及び探照灯操作

③ 信号等

- ア)非常配置の発令
- イ)船客の招集
- ウ)非常事態に対応する措置及び救命艇等の移乗割り当て
- エ)退船の発令
- オ) 退船の際、救命艇等に積み込む物品の明細

6 Muster List

6 - 1 Muster List

The Mariner's Law prescribes that the masters of those ships shown below shall provide the Muster List describing duties and manning of the crew in an emergency, and exhibit it at the appropriate places in the ship and also prescribes that the masters shall give the emergency training and drills to the crew and the passengers.

(1) Ships required to provide and exhibit a Muster List

(To call them "The ships required Muster List" hereafter)

- ① Passenger ships (as for the smooth water service ships, the requirement applied only to the ships engaging on specified service routes)
- ② Ships, other than passenger ships, which are engaging on ocean-going area and on greater coasting area
- ③ Specified fast boats (The ships required [High-Speed Craft Code] prescribed in SOLAS)
- Fishing vessels (except those exclusively operates in coasting area)

(2) Matters to be described in a Muster List

- ① Manning
 - a) Closing water-tight doors and others, Pumping water out, Preventing flooding
 - b) Closing fire doors and others, Shutting off ventilation, Operating fire protection system and appliance, and fire extinction work
 - c) Loading articles in the survival crafts, Lowering, launching and maneuvering them.

 Rescue work
 - d) Operating life-saving equipment and appliance
 - e) Mustering and guiding the passengers, checking that the passengers have donned their lifejackets suitably and other work to secure the passenger's safety
- ② On-scene command and Sub on-scene command
 - a) Water-proofing and fire-fighting
 - b) Works for survival crafts
 - c) Engine operation, radio communication, and handling search light of survival crafts
